Considering the current health situation in the country due to COVID-19 pandemic; CADEFIHUILA as an organization of small coffee producers and understanding that its associates are a vulnerable population to the negative impacts that this pandemic may create, it is important to support our coffee families in order to face this tough situation.

FLOCERT issued a statement giving viability for the use of Fairtrade Premium in advance to counter impacts on the small producers organizations affected by COVID-19.

"Dear Fairtrade partners.

In view of the current situation that faces the world caused by COVID-19 pandemic, Fairtrade role in supporting the livelihoods of small producers and workers becomes more important. As such Standards & Pricing, and with the support of the Criteria Committee, has issued an interpretation note to enable greater flexibility in the decision-making process and the use of Fairtrade Premium until the end of September 2020 to tackle critical circumstances during the pandemic caused by COVID-19 ”.

The Flo Committee and the Board of Directors of the Cooperative, in accordance with the provisions issued by FLOCERT and in order to mitigate the negative impact that has been generated in the coffee sector by COVID-19, approved to make the investment of FLO Fairtrade Premium in advance way, in which an individual economic aid will be provided for the associates of the Cooperative of up to COP\$ 400,000.

COLLECTION ASSISTED

Delivery of 2 coffee collecting canvas or its equivalent for invoicing a coffee demolition machine.

Description of coffee collecting canvas

- Sarán mesh with 70% shading, highlighted for its endurance and durability.
- It guarantees higher performance and prevents the Coffee Berry Borer (CBB) spreading.

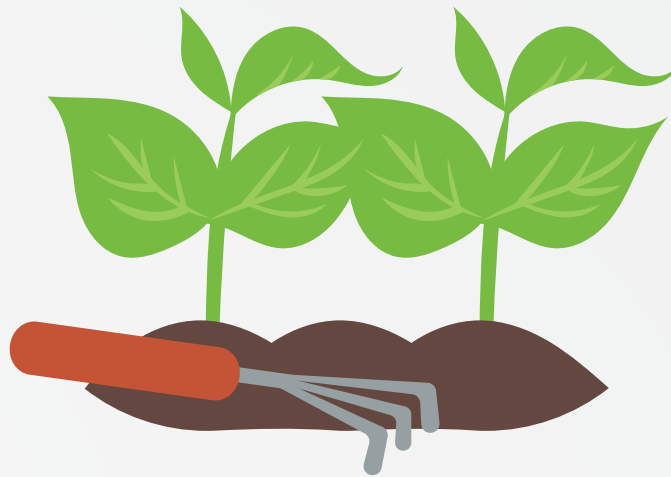

FOOD SAFETY

Long-term educational project: Delivery of seeds and / or reimbursement of the equivalent per poultry, fish farming investment, etc.



PROTECTION KIT

Delivery of the following protection elements such as: mouth masks, antibacterial gel, crop-spraying, alcohol and soap.

In the event that the associate one does not require any economic aid, once the FLO Development Plan is approved by the General Assembly of Delegates of the Cooperative, the equivalent amount of fertilizers may be delivered; it is necessary to clarify that it is subject to the availability of FLO Fairtrade Premium funds.

The beneficiaries of these aids are all the associates who registered at the Cooperative as of December 30, 2019. Those who were invalid; it means not being registered at that date, must be valid/active to access to the aid.

Each associate will be called to confirm the aid required and thus coordinate the delivery in our warehouses.

Associates who are over 70 years old and must not leave their homes, may designate the person who will come to claim the aid, this one must carry the associate original ID.
